## The business world at the heart of our teachings

SUP de V maintains close relationships with local professionals and has always integrated the company into its pedagogy.

# Our degrees



## RNCP Titles, these popular degrees !

A title is a professional certification recognized by the French State under the authority of *France Compétences* (National Authority of Financing and Regulatory for Professional Training and Apprenticeship).

Each title is registered on the National Directory of Professional Certifications (RNCP in French).

We award:

- Level 6 RNCP Title, an equivalent of a Bachelor
- Level 7 RNCP Title, an equivalent of a Master

This category of degree is focused on professional skills, facilitating employability and professional insertion.



## National degrees

The Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Innovation delivers a visa to our:

- BTEC Higher National Diplomas, a 2-year degree post baccalaureate (called BTS in French)
- University Bachelors and Masters thanks to a partnership with numerous universities

SUP de V must submit a request alongside the Commission for the Assessment of the Training Courses and Management Degrees (CEFDG in French) to have other degrees with this visa.

For example, the visa approved to the EGC Bachelor guarantee it an undeniable value.

Our programs are mostly in French. Some include a part of courses in English: Bachelor Marketing, Sales and Management ; Bachelor International business development manager ; International track of the Business Engineering Manager.

# International activities



## History and strategy

For several years, we have conducted different kind of activities in order to broaden the international skills of our apprentices and make them experience a new environment:

- study trips in group including courses at a partner university, company visits or workshops, cultural discoveries
- 3-month internship for our EGC bachelor students during their first year
- 6-month internship for our apprentices after the end of their contract
- common distant project implicating a collaboration between both academic staff, teachers and students of SUP de V and academic partners.

SUP de V got its first ECHE in 2014 and renewed it for 2021-27.



This new Erasmus charter as well as our participation in the Mona project constitute a major turning point in our international history with new projects for the coming years:

- semester of studies for our apprentices
- welcoming international students at SUP de V for a semester or studies or an internship
- Staff and teachers' mobility
- Creation of new academic partnerships.

To do so we created 2 offers for international students presented in the next pages.

## The Mona project

Mona « My Apprenticeship in Europe » is supported by the French government to encourage apprentices to move abroad during their curriculum for a long period (2 to 12 months). It was launched in 2022 and involves 43 professional schools in France piloted by the association EuroAppMobility.

For SUP de V apprentices it may take 2 forms:

- performing a professional mission in a company abroad for 2 or 3 months between the 1st and 2<sup>nd</sup> year of studies
- studying a semester abroad in a European school holding an Erasmus charter.

Following the principle of reciprocity SUP de V shall also receive students from partner schools for studies or internship.

# An internship in France



« Learn to collaborate with French professionals and enhance your skills»

As a student of a partner university of SUP de V, you may come for an internship in a company in Ile-de-France. We will provide assistance as follows:

\*Our career advisor will receive you in individual coaching to help prepare your applications (adaptation of CV and letter to the French market, recommendations for your research, put forward your experiences according to your project...)

\*Our commercial team will forward you internship offers and/or send your application to our partner companies who may be interested in your profile

\*Our international project manager will be available all along the process (applications reception, help for accommodation...)

3200 companies trust us every year by “hosting” our apprentices.

That includes international groups and Small and Medium Size companies from various activity sectors (industrial, automotive, banking and insurance...)

## Dates and conditions

Period: between February and July

Duration: 2 to 4 months

Your profile : bachelor or master student in one of our fields of expertise (mainly sales/business and marketing), French B1 and another language

Application : After informing your home institution, send your CV and cover letter, in French preferably, to our international project manager

Deadline: **3 months at the latest before the begin of your internship**

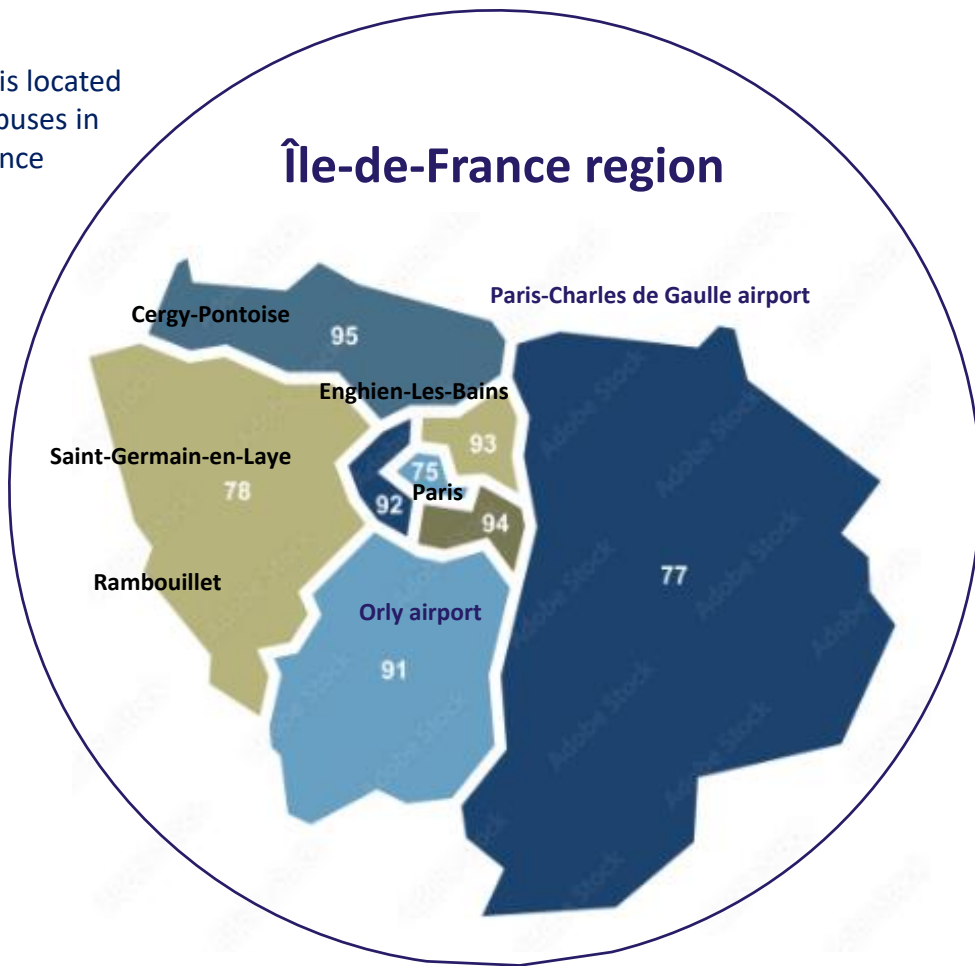


## Accommodation

SUP de V signed a regional partnership agreement with the managers of students houses (ARPEJ, AGEFO, ALJT, ALFI, SEMIR, STUDEFI, CROUS residence...). This allows our students to benefit of affordable housing and of the APL (Housing allowance).
